4. ***Communications to/from Members of the Public*** District Counsel and the District Engineer will report on communications to and from members of the public regarding District matters.

5. ***Budget Adoption for 2024-2025, Review of Financial Statement & Review of Audit Engagement Letter for FYE 06/30/2024*** The Trustees will conduct a second review of the proposed budget for the 2024-2025 fiscal year and consider the adoption of same. The Trustees will consider and review the District's financial and operating statements and budget as prepared by the District's accounting firm. The Trustees will review and consider for approval the Audit Engagement Letter for FYE 06/30/2024.

6. ***Adoption of Fees and Charges*** The Trustees will consider the extension of the District's schedule of fees and charges for the upcoming fiscal year.

7. ***Checks and Warrants*** The Trustees will approve a warrant to fund the District's revolving fund account and the issuance of checks to pay various recurring and routine expenses.

8. ***Engineer's Report*** The District Engineer will report on various matters concerning the routine operations and maintenance of District levees, roads, pumping and drainage facilities. The Trustees and Engineer will discuss the progress of vegetation removal and pest control. The District Engineer will discuss projected levee maintenance and flood protection work according to the adopted budget of the District. The Trustees will discuss flood emergency preparedness and the current efforts of San Joaquin County OES to coordinate flood preparedness and response. The District Engineer will report on the status of subvention reimbursement claims, as well as the District's application for the 2021-22 fiscal year. The District Engineer will report on the status of permit issuance and compliance matters and specifically the proposed compliance actions against certain homeowners.

9. ***Report of District Counsel*** District Counsel will report on matters of interest to the District and its landowners not included within the regular agenda. District Counsel will also report on his activities and participation in various flood control and flood prevention meetings as well as Counsel's activities with the City of Stockton, the

Reclamation Board of the State of California, Central Delta Water Agency and District Counsel's participation in the Advisory Water Commission of San Joaquin County.

10. ***Capital Expenditure Projects*** The Trustees will analyze the timing of capital expenditure projects. In addition, the acceleration of capital projects to take advantage of subvention funds remaining for this fiscal year and next fiscal year will be discussed and considered. The Trustees will discuss the cut-off wall projects on 14 Mile Slough, Calaveras River and Pinehurst Lake, and discuss progress of the projects.

11. ***Ten Mile Levee Issues*** The Trustees will discuss the progress of applying stone fill protection to the West face of Ten Mile levee as currently projected in the Army Corps of Engineers "Western Wall" plan for the protection of the Stockton area.
